All: Steadfast love and faithfulness will meet; righteousness and peace will kiss each other.

One: Faithfulness will spring up from the ground, and righteousness will look down from the sky.

All: God will give what is good, and our land will yield its increase.

One: Let us remember these essential qualities of people of faith: humility, gentleness, patience and love.


All: We confess our weakness and failure to accept others without judging them.
